LAUNCHING OF THE FIRST INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE PLATFORM TO TACKLE HUMAN - WILDLIFE COEXISTENCE ISSUES



Globally, there is a lack of means for sharing knowledge about the numerous local initiatives to better cope with human – wildlife coexistence issues. In response, the HISA association has established ENCOSH, the first collaborative exchange platform to share knowledge worldwide and to foster responsible approaches to coexistence challenges.



WHY THIS PLATFORM?

- Many people deal with similar human wildlife coexistence challenges: livestock injury and depredations, wildlife-vehicle collisions, crop-raiding...
- Numerous local initiatives have been tested around the world to deal with these issues: warning systems, guarding animals, repellents, compensation systems...
- There is **no single solution**: it is often **necessary** to **combine several measures** to prevent, minimize and offset the negative interactions between humans and wildlife.
- These initiatives could be successfully applied in different contexts.
- Sharing the wide variety of local knowledge and techniques that exist around the world will empower us to act better locally.
